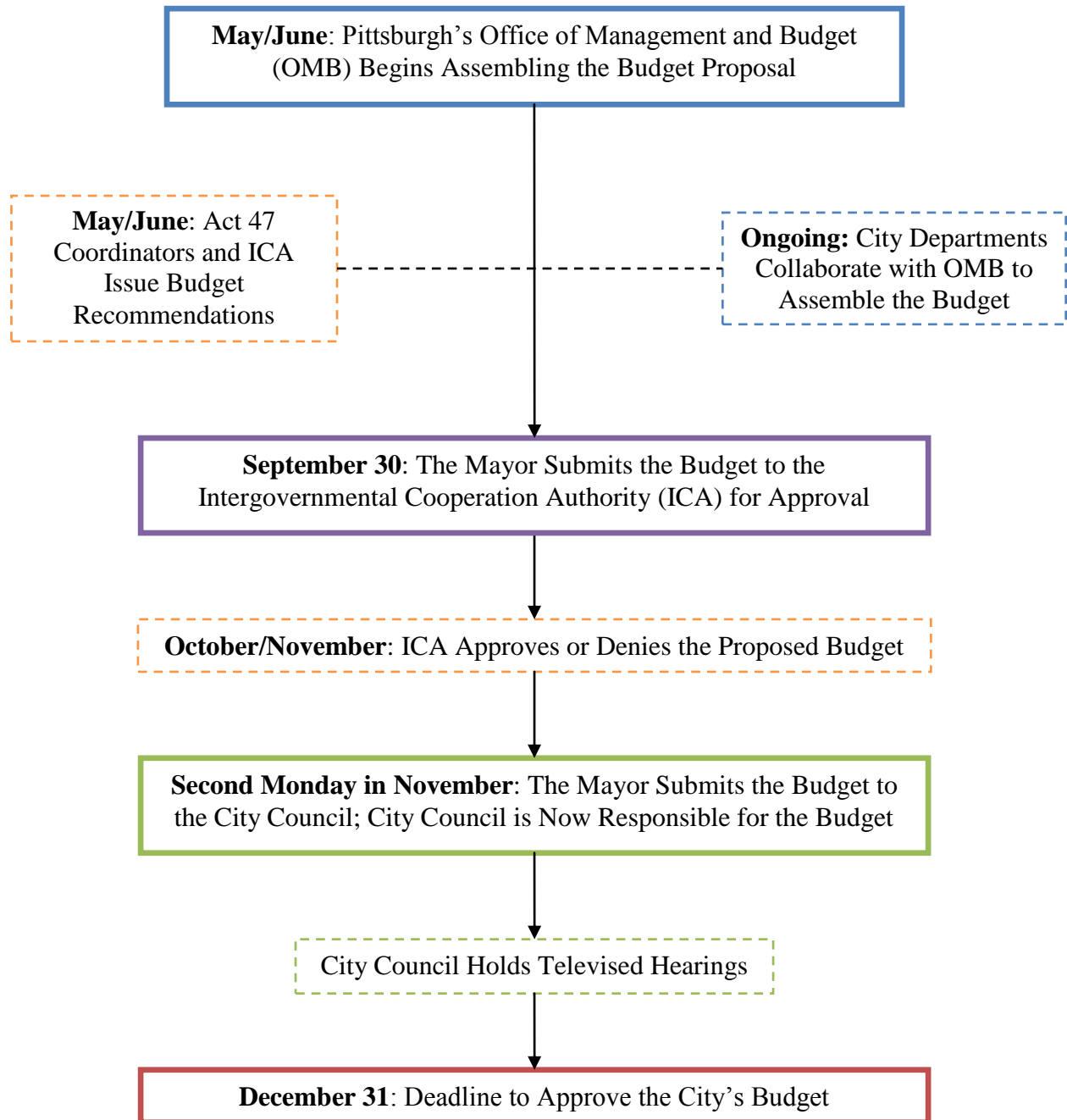


City of Pittsburgh Budget Process

The City of Pittsburgh's fiscal year begins on January 1 and ends on December 31. The budget process begins six months before the end of the Fiscal Year, with the final budget approved near the end of the fiscal year. Due to Pittsburgh's classification under Act 47, the city is currently working with appointed Act 47 Coordinators and the Intergovernmental Cooperation Authority (ICA) to design its FY 2015 budget. Below is a basic map of the budgeting process.
